

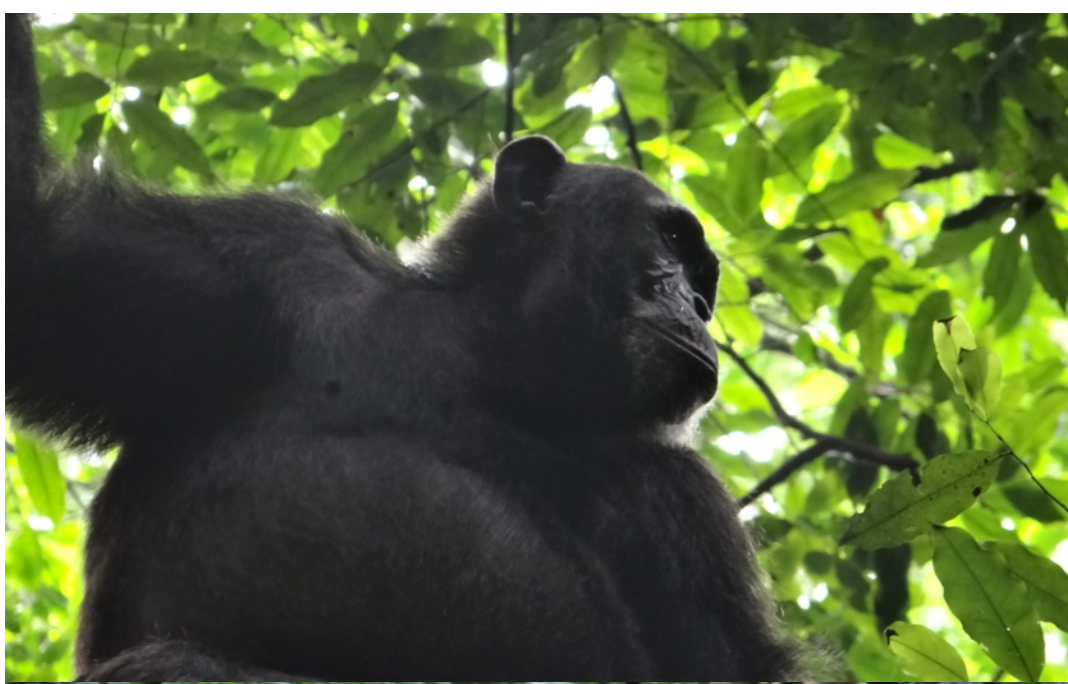
Our Stay at Budongo Forest Eco Lodge: A wonder-filled place for a cool respite in a Hot Game Park...
